PROJECT INSPIRE Links to Inspire

1) Advertise the fundraiser

create hype about the project with fliers, announcements, and through social networking print and hang the advertisement on page 3 around school

** Deadline for the project is **January 16th through January 27th**

2) Set price at 25 cents

Links should be sold for 25 cents a link. If your school sells 400 links you will raise 100 dollars!

3) Choose how you would like to participate in the project

By school- Your entire school can compete as a team, and if you reach your school goal give the entire class an award. Some great ideas are to have a teacher kiss a pig, get a male teacher to wear a dress, have the principal perform a dance for the whole school. Be creative, what would make your peers want to help out?!

*** TIP: Sell links during first hour or homeroom.

By grade- Each class (Seniors, Juniors, Sophomore, and Freshmen) will compete against each other and the grade level with the most links bought can win the title of most outstanding class. If your school does class competition, ask the principal or student council if you can award the winning class with spirits sticks, class awards, etc.

*** TIP: Sell links during lunch and have representatives from your club sell to the members.

By homeroom- Just as you would do if it were by class, each homeroom will compete against the others and the winning room can win a pizza party or a different award

By Club – if all else fails

4) Print the links and hang them around school

In order to make links, you should cut strips of paper and tape the ends to make a circle, making sure to link them together as you go! Be sure to hang them in a central location so your school can know just how much they've accomplished.

4) Total your money and send it off!

All checks must be postmarked by **February 3rd**.

Checks must be made out to the **Key Club District Office**

In the memo, write your division number and the word "Project Inspire Links"
