YEAR IN REVIEW – SCRAPBOOK CONTEST RULES

The competition is divided into two divisions, "**TRADITIONAL**" and "**NON-TRADITIONAL**."

Clubs are encouraged to enter a scrapbook containing pictures, souvenirs, examples, newspaper clippings, etc. of its activities throughout the current Key Club year, from District Convention to District Convention. No audio, visual, or computer equipment will be allowed as part of any scrapbook entry.

TRADITIONAL scrapbooks must be divided into the following categories: Service to School, Service to Community, Fundraising Projects, Assistance to Kiwanis Projects, Involvement with the Major Emphasis Program, and Miscellaneous. Each category must be tabbed accordingly. The pages must also be numbered with a table of contents included at the beginning.

NON-TRADITIONAL scrapbooks should adequately portray the same categories: Service to School, Service to Community, Fundraising Projects, Assistance to Kiwanis Projects, Involvement with the Major Emphasis Program, and Miscellaneous.

Complete rules for competing in this contest can be found in the annual Key Club International Guidebook.

FIRST, SECOND, and THIRD PLACE TROPHIES will be awarded for the outstanding scrapbooks in each Division, based upon the decision of the judges. The **FIRST** and **SECOND PLACE WINNERS** in the "TRADITIONAL" category are eligible to represent the District at this summer's Key Club International Convention.

NOTE: "Non-Traditional" entries do not have to win at the District Convention in order to be entered at the International Convention.
